**PLEASE READ THE FOLLOWING REGULATIONS:**

1. Camp only at designated location.
2. This Permit not valid within ¼ mile of campgrounds, day-use areas and boat landings.
3. Leave a clean campsite. Dispose of your garbage, cans, bottles, etc., in an authorized manner.
4. Be sure the campfire is out when you leave camp.
5. Do not cut any living trees or bushes.
6. You must be at least 18 years of age to register for a permit.
7. Permit is non-transferrable.
8. Permittee will be responsible for the actions and conduct of all persons at any campsite during the reservation period.
9. Permit may be revoked at any time when the permittee, permittee family member, or guest has been convicted of a violation of the State game laws, forest fire laws, or the regulations and guidelines of this permit as herein provided. In the event of such a conviction, no permits will be issued to said permittee for 5 years.

**HAVE A GOOD TIME!**

**Dispersed Camping Policy  
and Guidelines.**

The Department will issue free dispersed camping permits for the Price County Forest. Each camping unit requires its own permit. A maximum of 3 camping units allowed at one site. Camping is only allowed for 14-day intervals. One person/family unit per permit per 14-day interval. Permits are limited to 3 permits per year per person/family unit. A family unit is considered to include a parent or parents with their juvenile children.

Dispersed camping is not allowed within ¼ mile of campgrounds, day use areas and boat landings. Camping is available at the Solberg Lake, Smith Lake and Big Falls County Parks with a fee required. Tents, RVs and trailers are allowed.

Vehicles and camp may not block roadway or damage right-of-way. Please do not block trails, as we may need to access them in case of emergencies. Forest unit gates must not be blocked with vehicles, or they will be towed at the owner's expense. Vehicular traffic violations will result in a fine of no less than \$1,000.00 per County Ordinance 2024-01.

Firewood MAY NOT be transported into the County Forest Unit. Firewood gathering in the general vicinity of the camp is allowed. Firewood MUST BE dead or down – none can be taken home or removed from the forest unless a firewood permit is purchased from our office.

Campsites must be left in good condition. Nails are not allowed in trees, please use rope. Privy waste must be buried, and anything brought in must be brought out. Sites will be inspected, and citations may be issued.
